

International Graduate Student Admissions Checklist

Step 1: Apply for Admission

- Completed Discover Stockton Online Application
- Application fee \$50
- Standardized test scores (school code 2889):
 - English proficiency test results (TOEFL/IETLS/ELS 112 certificate)
 - GRE, MAT, or GMAT (if required by your graduate program)
- Official secondary school/college transcripts from either of the following credential evaluation agencies: WES or ECE.
- Three letters of recommendation sent electronically via the Discover Stockton Online Application
- Essay

Step 2: Applying for I-20 (student visa applicants)

- Acceptance letter from Stockton
- Application for I-20
- Affidavit of Support
 - Sponsor or personal bank statements in US Dollars (less than six months old)
 - Sponsor's proof of income
- Sponsor's Affidavit of free room and board (if you are living off campus with a family/friend)

If you are currently in the U.S. with a valid F-1 visa, the following documents must also be provided:

- Copy of all previous I-20 forms
- Copy of your most recent visa and I-94 (print the I-94 online: <https://i94.cbp.dhs.gov/>)
- International Student Transfer Form
- Official college transcripts from all attended institutions in the U.S.
