Spring 2002 Enrollment Report

-SUMMARY-

Spring 2002 Enrollment:

New Students

Undergraduate: The **557** new undergraduates who registered this semester include **25** first-time freshmen, **452** transfer students, and **80** readmitted students.

Graduate: **25** new students enrolled in four of Stockton's six graduate programs.

Headcount & FTE

Total Population: There are **6199** students registered, generating **5157** FTE.

Undergraduate: The **5914** students enrolled this semester represent a record headcount. The corresponding FTE, also a record, is **4960**.

Graduate: There are **285** students enrolled this semester with a corresponding FTE of **197**.

Matriculated vs. Non-matriculated Students: The percentage of matriculated undergraduate students remains stable at 95%, and increased from 80% to 83% for graduate students.

Credit load: Undergraduates maintained their average of 13.4 credits this semester, while graduate students increased their average credit load from 8.0 to 8.2.

AY01-02 Annualized¹ Headcount & FTE

Total Population: The combined annualized headcount is a record **6329** students, which exceeds last year's record by 2%. FTE generated was a record **5287**, and also exceeds last year's record by 2%.

Undergraduate: The AY01-02 annualized headcount for undergraduate students is **6025** students, a **2%** increase over the AY00-01 annualized headcount. The corresponding FTE is a record **5088**, an increase of 2%.

Graduate: The graduate annualized headcount is **304** students with a corresponding FTE of **199**.

¹ Annualized data are determined by averaging fall and spring headcount and FTE figures.
