**Galloway, NJ** - Stockton University's Master of Arts in Holocaust and Genocide Studies Program and the Sexual and Gender-Based Violence Teaching Circle are hosting a free film screening of Joshua Oppenheimer's documentary, "The Act of Killing."

The film, nominated for an Academy Award as best documentary feature in 2014, will be shown in the Campus Center Theatre at 6 p.m. on **Tuesday, February 23**. The film focuses on the present-day lives of individuals who participated in the Indonesian killings of 1965-66, in which almost a million people were killed followed a coup.
