Stockton's Office of Global Engagement will offer more than 30 events on the main Galloway campus which are free and open to the public.

The weeklong celebration begins with the 11th annual International Fair Trade Gift Fair on **Sunday, Nov. 15**. Other events throughout the week include the Get a Passport Campaign, study abroad tables and workshops, a lecture on Fulbright Scholarship opportunities for study and research abroad, a Peace Corps panel discussion, and various guest speakers and documentary screenings.
