

CITI Training Requirements

Prior to any involvement in research conducted at Stockton University, all Stockton University affiliates must complete online Conflicts of Interest and Responsible Conduct of Research (RCR) courses via the Collaborative Institutional Training Initiative (CITI) Program. All Stockton University affiliates are required to take additional courses based on their role in research.

The following training requirements apply to all faculty researchers, administrative staff, research staff, student researchers, faculty advisors, or any other individual who conducts or oversees research activities at Stockton University.

Role	Required Training
Student Learner	- Basics of Research for Student Learners
Student Researcher	- Student Researchers
Student Engaged in Dissertation, Thesis, or Distinction Projects	- Must enroll in Biomedical, Clinical, SBE, or Animal Researcher based on their area of study
Biomedical Researcher	- Biomedical Research Investigators - Revised Common Rule - Health Information Privacy and Security (HIPS) for Biomedical Researchers
Clinical Researcher	- Good Clinical Practice for Researchers Engaging in Clinical Practice
Social, Behavioral, and Education Researcher	- Social & Behavioral Research Investigators - Revised Common Rule - Health Information Privacy and Security (HIPS) for Social/Behavioral Researchers
Animal Researcher	- Working with IACUC - Minimizing Pain and Distress ¹ - Working with Animals ²
Biosafety Researcher ³	- Biosafety Level 1 or Recombinant DNA - Biosafety Level 2 - Biosafety Level 2 and Bloodborne Pathogens (Human Tissue Culture)
IRB Chairs and IRB Members	- IRB Members - Revised Common Rule - CITI Health Information Privacy and Security (HIPS) for IRB Members
IACUC Chairs	- IACUC Chair
IACUC Members ⁴	- Essentials for IACUC Members - IACUC Community Member

¹ Course is required if research falls into IACUC pain categories D or E.

² There are multiple Working with Animals courses covering a variety of species. Researcher must select course based on area of research.

³ Course selection is based on type of research being conducted.

⁴ IACUC members must select one of the two required courses based on their role.

Institutional and Signatory Official (Animal)	- Essentials of Research Administration - RCR Research Administrator - Institutional Official: Animal Care/Use
