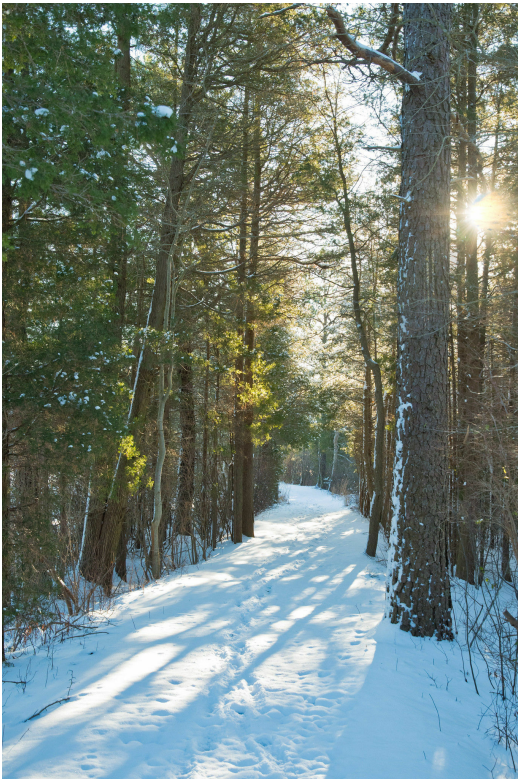
- What are some things that made you most excited during the semester?

Students returning to their housing assignment in the spring semester must check out no later than 12pm on **DECEMBER 18, 2019!**

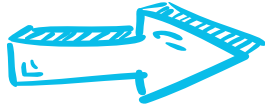
