- \* All award recipients must complete the FAFSA. Full-time enrollment only (12+credits per semester). Continuous enrollment required to maintain scholarship. Must maintain cumulative Stockton GPA of 3.0. Scholarship remains in effect for up to six (6) consecutive semesters for transfer students. Award cannot be used for summer courses.
