

LEARNING MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

Stockton University uses Blackboard Learn 9.1 as its learning management system. If you have never used Blackboard, you should take the time to become familiar with the environment. On demand support videos are available at <http://www.stockton.edu/bbsupport>. Click on the “Student Support” icon. The “Blackboard Overview” section is a good place to start.

Blackboard is accessible through the *goStockton* Portal. The portal is used for course registration and other functions. As a registered Stockton student you already have your username and password.

After logging into the *goStockton* portal, click on the Bb9 icon located in the toolbar at the top right portion of the screen. This will open the “My Courses” channel (also available on the Student Services tab). The “My Courses” channel includes answers to frequently asked questions and announcements related to system status.

To proceed to Blackboard, click on the Bb9 icon at the bottom of the “My Courses” channel.
