Please explain why you would like to be a social worker in the field of child welfare. Include any significant educational or professional experience(s) that may have influenced your decision. 2. What professional qualities and skills do you currently possess that will aid you in becoming an effective social worker in child welfare? What are some potential challenges you may face in becoming an effective social worker in child welfare? 3. Please state your understanding of the importance of diversity and difference in shaping life experiences. Why is this especially important to understand when working with the children and families of New Jersey? 4. What do you know about the efforts underway in New Jersey to transform child welfare services for vulnerable children and their families? How might you contribute toward these efforts as part of BCWEP?
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In completing this application, I affirm that the information provided herein is complete, true, and correct, and that I am not in default in payment of any federal educational loan. In addition, I understand that, if offered funding for study, I will be required to sign a legally binding contract committing myself, among other things, to complete my social work degree program expeditiously and, to accept and maintain employment in the New Jersey Division of Child Protection and Permanency (DCP&P) for two calendar years following graduation.
