Coordinate all practicum requirements with DCFS Employer to maintain employment during schooling.

#### Student is offered:

1/3 Tuition Waiver every semester (up to 9 semesters)

\$3,000 stipend Fall and Spring Semesters (up to 6 semesters)








**EMPLOYED TWO OR MORE**

### **EMPLOYMENT LONGEVITY**

Total Average length of employment: 9.7 Years

- Average Employment Length prior to graduation: 7.4 Years
- Average Employment Length post-graduation: I.9 Years
  - Average length from three cohorts post-graduation
    - Class of 2011: 3.1 out of 8 year average
    - Class of 2014: 2.4 out of 5 year average
    - Class of 2017: 1.8 out of 2 year average

Search for Employment for a minimum of 3 months after graduation – if hired will work for a minimum of 12 months full-time, 24 months part-time

#### Student is offered:

\$3,000 stipend Fall and Spring Semesters (up to 2 semesters)








### RACE/ETHNICITY

### EMPLOYMENT LONGEVITY


- 40% of the 57 students employed after graduation are still employed with the division
- I.99 year average length of employment for all BSW Title IVE participants (including those who did not obtain employment with DCFS) (All 84 students)
- 3.19 year average length of employment for all BSW Title IVE participants who did obtain employment with DCFS (57 Students)
- Average length of employment for those who obtain careers at DCFS based on number of years possible in table to the right.
