Peer Review Criteria
1. Application consisted of coherent, clear responses (easy to read/understand).
2. Proposed presentation is relevant to Stockton community audience
3. 1-2 sentence description is clear and aligned to the title
4. Abstract summary is 6-8 sentences.
5. Abstract summary is clear/understandable in explaining the topic to be presented.
6. Abstract summary indicates a scholarly/creative activity relevant to the Celebration of Scholarship & Teaching
7. Application is aligned to selected primary discipline area.
8. Application is aligned to strategic plan objectives selected.
9. Topic proposed is appropriate for format chosen (poster, roundtable, presentation, panel presentation)
10. Topic is likely to be adequately covered in amount of time requested.
Optional: provide comments or suggestions regarding this application.
