WHAT IS PADLET?

- A virtual bulletin board
- Faculty and students share ideas, thoughts, photos and images.
- Easy to use from mobile devices, tablets or computer.
- Enhances lessons in all courses.

HOW TO USE PADLET:

- 1) Create an account. www.padlet.com
- 2) Log in via Facebook or Google.
- 3) Start creating your padlet. (link this to tutorials from Padlet?)
- 4) Choose a wall design by using the “modify” button on the right-hand side.
- 5) Give your wall a name.
- 6) Copy and paste the link and share with students

PADLET A CREATIVE TOOL VIRTUAL NOTEPAD

Uses for Padlet

STUDENTS CAN:

- Have interactive discussions
- Share and keep class or project notes?
- Keep research for group projects
- Use as an electronic portfolio tool?
- Ask questions during a virtual lesson so that teachers know what concepts need further explanation.
- THINKING MAP: Students design a map of main concepts in a unit of study.

TEACHERS CAN:

- Give statements or questions that students discuss together.
- Use as a repository for students’ work
- Exit Ticket Padlet: Students let teachers know what they learned in the lesson, what additional questions they have, what were the main points of the lesson.
- Classroom newsletter
- Introductions- a way to get to know each other.
