# TRANSFER EDUCATION STUDENTS

## Suggestions for completing your course selections

1. Check to see if all of your expected credits transferred in from your last school. If not, please pull up/print a copy of your latest transcripts online for our review with you.
2. Check to see if your DegreeWorks course audit is showing that you have a concentration in Education. If **not**, please let an Education Advisor/staff member know so you can add Education to your program today.
3. If you are transferring from a NJ Community College, check the back of this sheet to see if you took any of the corresponding Education Professional Requirement courses. If a course you completed is not showing on your DegreeWorks audit, let the orientation leader/advisor you are working with know so we do not suggest the same course.
4. If you are going to be playing a sport, and are unsure of your practice times, ask an orientation leader for the list of times so you may plan accordingly.

\*\***EDUC 2231** Development of the Learner may be taken at Stockton in place of both the Developmental and Educational Psychology course requirements if you have not taken them already.

5. Do you have 48+ credits transferring in?
  - a. Register for EDUC 2000 Gateway for NJ Teaching Profession
6. Review your DegreeWorks course audit for needed courses. We suggest:
  - a. Two courses in your content major area
  - b. One General Studies Elective course (GSS 3360 if you have not completed the EDUC 1515 Diversity requirement)
  - c. One Education course from the Professional Requirement course list above if needed.
