== Precepting Days ==

Preceptor(s) will contact you next week to set up an appointment. All classes are canceled to make time for this important planning opportunity. **Seniors and juniors** should schedule closer to Tuesday, 3/30, the first Precepting Day. **Sophomores and freshmen** generally make appointments closer to the following Wednesday, 4/7, the second Precepting Day. == Students Entering Clinical Experience or Clinical Practice ==

Sophomore-Juniors-Seniors: if you have completed EDUC 2000 Gateway **and** you have met all the requirements to register for any EDUC 3100, 3101, 4600, or 4990 clinical course, you will receive a personalized email message that links to a fieldwork precepting power point. After viewing the slide presentation, please click the Fieldwork Application Link. You **MAY** do this before your precepting meeting.

You will also receive a Precepting Checklist Survey to read and SAVE. You must review the checklist **during** your precepting meeting. Please **WAIT** until you are in the meeting with your preceptor to click the Checklist Survey link.
