

# 2. Is there a need for licensed MA counselors at the national level? In NJ? In South NJ?

### National:

As you can see in the charts above, yes, there is a need for licensed MA counselor at the national level, as the field is going to grow by 20% and hiring is going to have to increase to meet this demand.

### New Jersey:

Also, the job outlook in NJ is at +18%, which is well above average, and again indicates a need for counselors to meet this demand

The Educational and health services industry sector, which mental health counselors fall into, is the sector with the highest projected employment growth in the state of NJ (see slide 12: <a href="http://lwd.dol.state.nj.us/labor/lpa/employ/indoccpj/14-24\_indocc\_projections\_sp.pdf">http://lwd.dol.state.nj.us/labor/lpa/employ/indoccpj/14-24\_indocc\_projections\_sp.pdf</a>)

All of the data that is available indicates a definitive growth in the field and a need for licensed MA counselors.

3. Is it feasible to offer an MA program in Counseling Psychology at Stockton based on national and local job trends? In other words, is there going to be need/are there going to be jobs for our proposed MA in counseling psychology graduates based on the current job outlook for masters level counselors?

Based on the information outlined above, yes it would be feasible to offer an MA program in Counseling Psychology, because there is going to be demand in the field and job opportunities for counseling psychology graduates. NOTE: It would be extremely preferable that this program would have CACREP accreditation as this streamlines the licensure process and would significantly increase the hire ability of our graduates, especially in government positions.
