

International Students Admission Checklist

Step 1: Apply for Admission

- Completed admissions application
- Application fee \$50 (non-refundable)
- Official standardized tests scores
 - English proficiency test results
 - SAT or ACT (if you are from an English-speaking country) – **Undergraduate**
 - GRE, MAT or GMAT (as required by the program) – **Graduate**
- Official secondary school/college transcripts or credential evaluation report from a Stockton approved credential evaluation agency
- One to two recommendation letters
- Essay
- Copy of passport biographical page

*Shortly after submitting your Stockton admissions application, please begin preparing your materials for your **Application for I-20**.*

Step 2: Apply for I-20 (student visa applicants)

- Acceptance letter from Stockton
- Application for I-20
- Affidavit of Support
 - Sponsor or personal bank statements in US Dollars (less than six months old)
 - Sponsor's proof of income
- Sponsor's Affidavit of free room and board (if you are living off campus with a family/friend)

If you are currently in the U.S. with a valid F-1 visa, the following documents must also be provided:

- Copy of all previous I-20 Forms
- Copy of your most recent U.S. visa
- Copy of your most recent I-94 (print the I-94 online: <https://i94.cbp.dhs.gov/>)
- F-1 International Student Transfer From
