Interested in becoming a Field Clinical Educator for the Master of Science in Communication Disorders Program?

Responsibilities: This portion of clinical education is important in preparing students for the field of speech-language pathology. Clinical Educators are encouraged to permit the student to start with some observation, and then employ a gradual release of responsibility **based on the student clinician's needs and experience.** When the student becomes more independent, the expectation of the field clinical educator will be to provide supervision (direct observation) **at least 25% of the time** <u>for each</u> <u>client</u>; however, be on site 100% of the time, according to ASHA's requirements. Some other supervisory responsibilities include determining goals and expectations of the clinician, approving case logs, completing evaluations, providing developmental feedback, and maintaining contact with the course instructor.

Requirements: ASHA requires that all clinical educators have completed at least 9 months of clinical practice **post attainment of CCC**, <u>AND then</u> have completed at least 2 hours of continuing education in the field of supervision.
