- 1 night Utrecht, Netherlands with stop in Amersfoort following the life stories of two Holocaust survivors, Jack Lewis & Maud Dahme.
- 1 night Amiens, France visiting sites of the Battle of the Sommes on WWI western front.
- 2 nights Caen, Normandy (France) with full day visit to D-Day Landing Sites
- 3 nights Paris, France and the opportunity to trace the life story of Holocaust survivor Dan Kochavi, touring the Memorial de la Shoah Museum, The Shoah Memorial in Drancy & Site of Drancy Internment Camp, visit to Eiffel.
