## SUMMARY STATEMENTS

### TOTAL ENROLLMENT

- Total headcount for Fall 2012 has increased by 4% to 8400, compared with 8,108 for Fall 2011. Total FTE increased by 5% to 7723 from the previous Fall's 7369.

### NEW STUDENT ENROLLMENT

- New undergraduate students:
  - There are 1003 new freshmen—3% more than the previous Fall, and 1,092 transfer/re-admits—a decrease by 4%
  - The average combined SAT (Verbal and Math) for first-time regularly admitted freshmen is 1110 - a slight decrease from last year's 1117, and the average high school rank is the 79<sup>th</sup> percentile—slightly higher than the Fall 2011 freshman class.
- New graduate students:
  - There are 295 new graduate students enrolled—a 9% increase from the previous Fall.

### UNDERGRADUATE ENROLLMENT

- Undergraduate FTE increased by 5% to 7201 from last Fall's 6,885, while the actual headcount of undergraduate students increased by 4% to 7516 from last Fall's 7,240.
- Gender distribution for total undergraduate population remains the same as last year: 58% female and 42% male.

### GRADUATE ENROLLMENT

- Graduate and post-baccalaureate FTE increased by 8% to 522 from Fall 2011, while headcount increased by 2% to a total of 884 students, compared with the previous Fall.
