SUMMARY STATEMENTS

Spring 2010 Enrollment

New Students:

Undergraduate: The 550 new undergraduates who registered this semester represent 18 first-time freshmen, 461 transfer students, and 71 readmitted students.

Graduate: The graduate program enrolled 108 new students.

Doctoral Program in Physical Therapy:

There are currently 69 students enrolled in the DPT program and 24 students enrolled in the transitional DPT program.

Headcount & FTE:

Total Population: There are 7297 students registered, generating 6487 FTE.

Undergraduate: The College enrolled 6594 students this semester generating 6084 FTE.

Graduate (including post baccalaureate): There are 703 students enrolled this semester with a corresponding FTE of 403.

Matriculated vs. Non-Matriculated Students: The percentage of matriculated undergraduate students increased slightly to 98% while the percentage of matriculated graduate students increased from 87% to 90%.

Credit Load: Undergraduate credit load increased to 14.8 credits per student. Graduate students' average credit load also increased to 6.9 credits per student.

AY 09-10 Annualized Headcount & FTE**

Total Population: The combined annualized headcount is 7428, which is a 4% increase from last year's number. Annualized FTE increased by 6%

Undergraduate: The AY09-10 annualized headcount for undergraduate students is 6704; an increase of 2% from the AY08-09 annualized headcount. The corresponding FTE is 6183; a 6% increase over last year's figure of 5849.

Graduate: (including post baccalaureate): The graduate annualized headcount is 725, which is an 18% increase, and 412 FTE, a 24% increase.
