Galloway, N.J. — A panel of cannabis industry experts will lead a free online webinar focusing on cannabis tourism in Atlantic City at 1 p.m. Thursday, March 7.

The webinar, titled “Destination Cannabis: Spotlight on Atlantic City,” will discuss legal recreational cannabis and its development as a tourism amenity in the resort.

Rob Mejia, a teaching specialist in Cannabis Studies at Stockton, will serve as moderator. Mejia is the author of multiple books written specifically to introduce adults to the cannabis industry and is the president of Our Community Harvest: A Cannabis Education Company.
