Galloway, NJ – The Stockton Center on Successful Aging is sponsoring a series of workshops for older adults at the Atlantic County Library System – Egg Harbor Township Community Meeting Room on 1 Swift Drive, Egg Harbor Township.

Tom Sandor, a local artist and SCOSA volunteer, will be instructing the autumn session of "Learn to Draw" workshops.

Guided by Sandor's experience and expertise, participants will learn to draw what they "see," at their own pace, developing powers of observation and defining individual style. With emphasis on self-discovery and skill development, the class will focus on building and refining basic skills, exploring a broad range of drawing materials and sharing ideas and techniques. Participants must purchase and bring their own materials. No experience necessary, however those with a sample of previous work are encouraged to bring it to the class.

The class will meet on Wednesdays from 10 a.m. to noon on Sept. 9, 16, 23, 30 and Oct. 7, 14, 21 and 28.
