Galloway Twp., NJ- The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey will host the Annual Pre-Kwanzaa Celebration presented by the Unified Black Students Society on **Friday, December 3, 2010**, beginning at 7:00 p.m. in the I-Wing Gymnasium here.

Although Kwanzaa, a week-long celebration of African-American heritage and culture happens between December 26 and Jan 1, Stockton hosts its celebration early because the campus is closed at that time for the holiday break.

The Pre-Kwanzaa celebration is free and open to the entire community. The program will include libations, a spoken word presentation, dance, music and a Kwanzaa Feast. Dinner will be served in N-Wing Cafeteria immediately following the program. Admission to the dinner is by wristband to be distributed at the event.
