To assist veterans in finding employment, the Continuing Studies Department of Stockton College in collaboration with the Atlantic Cape May Workforce Investment Board will be hosting the event. The conference is designed to help all levels of job seekers...from the recently discharged veteran to veterans from previous conflicts.

During the program a career assessment instrument will be used to help veterans retool their job search.
