		The RFP references two (2) accounts/meters as follows:  <b>2.</b> The main meter account serves the main academic complex and Housing 2 & 3 - ACE acct.# 55507176831, the current capacity/transmission peak load contribution as of January 2024 is 4936.95 / 5265.36.  <b>3.</b> The additional account serves Housing 1 and part of Housing 5 (Bldgs. 124 & 125)- ACE acct # 55006718369, the current capacity/transmission peak load contribution as of January 2024 is 334.32 / 419.57.  Are these meters both located on the Galloway campus? The Atlantic City campus? One meter/account at each campus?  <b>Both meters are located at the Galloway campus.</b>

	2	Question & Answer
		Regarding Exhibit C: This exhibit states that it is for bidders under a construction contract with the University, which this solicitation is not for. Can the University please confirm that Exhibit C is not applicable to this RFP/scope of work?  <b>Exhibit 'C' is not a requirement for this RFP.</b>

	3	Question & Answer
		There are a few provisions that apply to the procurement of traditional goods and services and that are inapplicable to demand response. Letting these provisions stand could risk a breach of contract even if one of the provisions does not apply to Demand Response. Would the University agree to strike them?  The sections that do not apply are (1) Title and Risk of Loss; Inspection (included in the Terms and Conditions document) (2) Additional Work and/or Special Projects (included in the RFP document), and (3) Contractor's Warranty & Remedies for Failure to Comply with Contract Requirements subsection A. (included in the RFP document).  The University is willing to negotiate Contractual terms with the Awarded Vendor during the Contract phase. At that time, the Awarded Vendor will have the opportunity to suggest modifications, pending the University's approval. However, Bidders are cautioned there is no guarantee that the University's General Counsel will strike any terms, and should submit without any expectation of modification.
