# Call for Proposals – CDC Career Development Committee

The Grants Office is now accepting CDC Applications. The deadline for filing applications is Monday, May 5<sup>th</sup> at 4:30pm.

Be sure to look over the <u>guidelines</u> for answers to your questions regarding application criteria, eligibility, and funding priority.

One complete hard copy of the application should be delivered to the Grants Office in E-226 along with one complete electronic (scanned) copy to grants @stockton.edu. Both copies must be received by deadline.

### **Internal Grant Funding Available**

The Grants Office offers an array of funding opportunities for Faculty members to support and encourage their scholarship. Awards are limited to one request from each fund per fiscal year, and intended to supplement other funds, as appropriate.

To apply, the PI should complete the request on the appropriate form. An approved award will be processed with the PI's school handling the paperwork.

## **Funding for Publication, Exhibit, Performance Charges, or Professional Poster**

- To defray costs required by publisher or venue as condition of completing the project.
- Award up to \$500.

#### **Book Subvention Funding**

- Offers subsidies to defray costs required by the publisher as condition of publication.
- Generally \$750 average award.

### **Funding for Principal Investigator Travel**

- Supports PI travel to discuss proposal with program officer of external funding agency.
- \$100 to \$500 toward travel costs to meet with outside funding agency.
