Monique joins us as a Grant Assistant, assisting in proposal development and submissions to external sponsors. We look forward to her growing with our team in her new role.

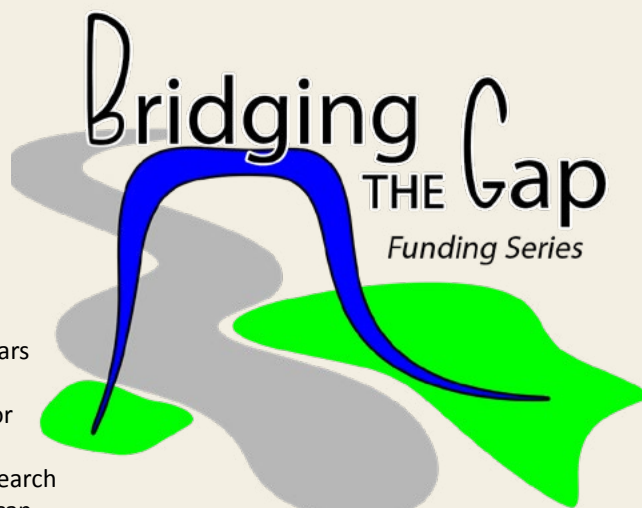
Is it time to seek External Funding for your project?
