The strengthening of our community partnerships and combining of resources are vital in combating the communal issue of alcohol and drug addiction and dependency. It is important that Stockton support the students in recovery with resources that provide a safe place for their success.

Stockton University offers an exciting opportunity for students who are in recovery. Recovery Housing is a residential community where students support each other's continued sobriety. Recovery Housing offers 9 or 12 month options in an unmarked campus housing location. The community will have easy access to University resources such as Wellness Services, which includes Counseling, Alcohol & Other Drug Assistance Programs & Psychiatric Services, 12-Step and SMART Recovery Meetings, counseling, health services, nutritional counseling, group relaxation techniques that include meditation and fitness classes, all free of charge to Stockton students. The program will also offer a dedicated Resident Assistant and organized activities such as sporting events, plays, hikes, bike trips, intramurals and other campus events.



- Support during the highlights and challenges that come with the pursuit of a life in recovery

How to apply for Recovery Housing

- Must be a Stockton student
- Be eligible to live in campus housing
- In person or telephone interview with the Director of Counseling and the Assistant Director of Counseling-Addictions
- In person or telephone interview with the Director of Residential Life or designee
