Mr. Keenan began his own walk to be his true self over thirteen years ago. He is a steadfast advocate and mentor for the LGBTQA+ community. He is dedicated to helping LGBTQA+ youth, particularly Trans youth, who are so often targeted and experience higher rates of homelessness, violence, and poor health outcomes than their peers. This presentation will focus on Mr. Keenan's programs he has implemented as PRIDE Center Program Director at the Center For Family Services (CFFS), and a discussion of the stark disparities that Trans youth face.



Mr. Keenan has been working in the Human Services field since 1994. He has worked with various populations, from homeless youth, adults with mental illness and other co-occurring disorders, and LGBTQA+ youth and adults. Currently, he serves as a Program Director and LGBTQ+ Youth Lead Advocate at CFFS, headquartered in Camden, NJ.
