INFORMATION ABOUT MAJORS AND COURSE SELECTION

CRIM (Criminal Justice)

- You must earn a C or higher in all CRIM courses
- Take CRIM 1100 (Intro) Fall '20
- Defer Q1 and take CRIM 2145 (Statistics in Criminal Justice-Q1) Spring '21 or later
- Let us know if you have applied and been accepted into the dual degree program

ECON (Economics)

• Take ECON 1200 (Intro to Macro) Fall '20, then ECON 1400 (Intro to Micro) Spring '21 or later

GERO (Gerontology)

Counts as cognate for any SOBL major

POLS (Political Science)

- Take POLS 1100 or POLS 2100 or POLS 2140
- Do NOT take POLS 3150 (Intro to Pol Methodology-Q1) until junior/senior year
- Consider FRST 2310 (Algebraic Problem Solving) or another Q1 or defer Q1 to Spring '21

PSYC (Psychology)

- Defer Q1 until Spring '21
- Take PSYC 1100 (Intro) Fall '20 UNLESS
- You have credit for Intro already [AP PSYC credit (3, 4, or 5) or county college PSYC 101 credit]
- Then consider PSYC 2301 Social Psychology (online) or PSYC 2211 Abnormal (AC Campus)
- You may also be able to take PSYC 3322 Lifespan or PSYC 3323 Developmental online

SOCY (Sociology)/ANTH (Anthropology)

- Take SOCY 1100 (Intro) or ANTH 1100 (Intro)
- Or take both (only one required, but a second can be used as a program elective)
- Consider FRST 2310 (Algebraic Problem Solving) or defer Q1

SOWK (Social Work)

- Take SOWK 1101 (Intro)
- Consider SOWK 1103 (Human Behavior/Social Environment) must take before Fall '22 (jr)
- Consider SOWK 2504 (Race, Ethnicity, Diversity) must take before Fall '22 (jr)
- Consider FRST 2310 (Algebraic Problem Solving) or defer Q1
- Consider PSYC 1100 (Intro) in Fall '20 (you'll need later for PSYC 2211 or PSYC 3302)
