PRAXIS II:

Are you making a plan to take the PRAXIS II? Praxis II scores: \${e://Field/Praxis_II_Scores} PRAXIS II is due during your CP I placement. Deadlines: April 1st for a FALL placement in CP II and October 1st for a SPRING placement in CP II.

You will have to wait up to 28 days before retaking a failed Praxis exam. Plan accordingly.

PRAXIS II for Summer CP I:

If are planning on taking Clinical Experience in Spring 2024 and Clinical Practice I in Summer 2024, the deadline to pass Praxis II is **February 1st** with a mandatory meeting that must be attended on February 1st, 2024. You will receive an email with more information. (Select yes if you plan to do so or no if you do not.)

Leave or vacation plans:

Discuss planning any time away with your preceptor and make a plan to check with the Education office staff during your absence. Mandatory meetings can occur between semesters. In addition, a vacation may not be taken during student teaching (Fall- Sept through Dec, Spring- Jan through May).

Financial Aid:

If you receive financial aid, check the number of total credits you're planning to take next term. Many plans require full time status (12+ credits). Talk to your preceptor about additional courses to take if needed. Be sure to consider summer tuition if you plan to opt for that term.

Praxis Test Billing:

Students may opt-in to have Praxis fees added to your bursar bills. Bookmark the School of Education FAQ (https://stockton.edu/education/fag.html) for more information.

Substitute Teaching:

Districts often require substitute certification in place to complete clinical hours including student teaching in their buildings. For this reason, we strongly recommend you obtain yours. Additionally, schools are paying \$125-\$175 per day to anyone with a substitute teacher certification (https://www.nj.gov/education/license/sub/Applicant%20Procedures%20for%20Sub%20Credential.pdf
