The Academic Policies Committee (APC) met six times during AY 23-24. We reviewed five procedures, two policies, and one policy-procedure pair (Table 1).

Of the items reviewed by APC this academic year, **Policy II-13 Student-Load Categories** took the most time. In summary, APC requested and received data from Institutional Research relating to GPA and credits attempted. After initial APC discussion, the APC chair attended a meeting of the Student Affairs standing committee, where it was agreed that additional data would be helpful. APC got that data from IR and assessed it. Further APC discussions were had and a draft report sent to Senate exec. This will be discussed at the May Senate retreat. APC anticipates final recommendations for this policy and its procedure partner to be the first items considered in Fall 2024.

The second major item of discussion in APC this year was **Procedure 6120 Faculty Leave and Attendance**. This was discussed at multiple APC meetings including with the faculty who requested the procedure review. After many drafts, a suggested revision has been sent to the Senate Executive Committee with a recommendation that the Union review before additional actions are taken.

The remaining items reviewed by APC were minor revisions and efficiently moved through the Senate approval process. There were several items from last academic year that we expect follow up on at the start of next academic year (Table 2).

The chair thanks all committee members their excellent work this year as well as the faculty and other guests who came to APC meetings to share with us and help inform our decisions.
