Galloway Township, NJ- The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey is offering free use of computers and access to device charging for Ocean County residents impacted by Hurricane Sandy.

“There are still some areas of Ocean County without power,” said Eileen Conran-Folks, Manager of Stockton’s Manahawkin Instructional Site. “In other areas where power has been restored, many homes remain too damaged to re-connect. We are happy to be here for folks who need to communicate with loved ones, insurance companies, home repair companies and the like.”

Local residents may use the computers at the Manahawkin facility, located at 712 East Bay Avenue, Suite 20, in Manahawkin, for this purpose, Conran-Folks said. Residents may also come to the facility and charge their phones, tablet computers and other electronic devices.

In addition, Stockton is serving as a collection center for people wishing to donate clothing and personal items such as toiletries. “Anyone wishing to donate may drop them off here and we will make certain the items find their way to the proper shelters and agencies,” Conran-Folks said.

The Manahawkin Instructional Center is open Monday-Friday from 8:15 a.m. to 4:45 p.m.; Monday evenings from 5 p.m. to 8:45 p.m.; Tuesdays from 5 p.m. to 9:45 p.m.; and Thursdays from 5 p.m. to 7:45 p.m. The site will close at 1 p.m. on Wednesday, November 21 through Monday 26th in observation of Thanksgiving. It will re-open on Tuesday, November 27.
