Galloway, NJ – Stockton University's Manahawkin Instructional Site will offer help and provide information to students thinking about transferring to the university on **Thursday, Nov. 5**.

Steve Phillips, a Stockton Transfer Admissions representative, will assist prospective students from 10 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. at the site, 712 East Bay Ave., Manahawkin, NJ. Cynthia McCloskey, an academic adviser, will also be on hand from 1 - 6 p.m. to advise current or transfer students about academic programs.

Prospective students should bring up-to-date college transcripts, which will enable Phillips to provide an "instant decision" in most cases as to whether they are eligible for admission to Stockton University.

Stockton is among the Top 15 public Regional Universities of the North, ranked at #12 by *U.S. News & World Report* in its 2016 edition of "America's Best Colleges." It offers small classes taught by distinguished faculty members on the 2,000-acre campus in Galloway, NJ and in Hammonton, Woodbine and Atlantic City, as well as Manahawkin.

Stockton's Manahawkin site, near the Garden State Parkway and the beaches of Long Beach Island, is a convenient location to begin or continue one's academic career. The site offers general education courses, continuing education courses and a wide range of academic and community-based programs throughout the year.
